TIPS for Kids is the Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and Related Disabilities (LEND) training program in Missouri. The program is funded by a grant from the Maternal and Child Health Bureau in the Department of Health and Human Services. The purpose of the program is to enhance outcomes for children with autism and other developmental disabilities by training future healthcare professionals, families, and self-advocates in evidence-based, interdisciplinary, family-centered, and culturally competent practices. Applicants should be in good academic standing with their department. Accepted applicants are required to pass a background check per MU Healthcare policies.
