



# FREE KCOU-FM AUTISM PROGRAM

KCOU FM 88.1, Mizzou's student run radio station, is pleased to offer an exciting and unique 5-week program for individuals age 13-18 with Autism Spectrum Disorder and a passion for sports broadcasting.



This free program will provide participants with the opportunity to:



- Connect with mentors from the sports broadcasting department at KCOU
- Learn basics about radio broadcasting
- Practice on air skills and visit radio station studio
- Demonstrate knowledge of sports

Program begins this fall and meets one evening a week for 90 minutes at University of Missouri-Columbia campus. This program is not intended for children who require 1:1 behavioral support or who have significant non-compliant or maladaptive behaviors such as aggression or self-injury. Program mentors will receive training from the University of Missouri Thompson Center for Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders. Completed application required by September 30, 2015.
